COVID Safety Team Officer (CSTO) – Training Responsibilities

In response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic, each training group/team is required to have a nominated COVID Safety Team Manager.

Objectives

To promote and ensure good hygiene practices amongst participants.

Responsibilities

Administration

- Maintaining Training Attendance register, and submit to Club COVID Safety Officer.
- Ensure that any participant who arrives for training feeling unwell is asked to leave training immediately.

Education and Support

• Promote a culture of COVID-19 safety for the health and wellbeing of participants.

At Training

- Ensure that all participants use the designated entry/exit points and arrive and leave as per the training schedule and protocols.
- Ensure and remind all participants to adhere to the strictly no contact and 1.5m Social Distancing protocols.
- Ensure that prior and following training all participates sanitise their hands at the designated entry/exit point.
- Ensure that club provided footballs are wiped with antibacterial wipes or alcoholbased sanitiser prior to and after training sessions.
- Ensure the one person handles equipment i.e. cones, to reduce point of contact.
- Discourage members of the public from entering the training venue.

Requirements:

- Must have a valid Working with Children Check (WWCC)*
- Must complete the Australian Government's online COVID-19 Infection Control Training *
- Must undertake training on protocols and hygiene, as directed by the Club

*Qualifications to be provided to COVID Safety Officer or uploaded into Everproof.
